

# Rethink your office: seven scenarios for planning office space after the COVID-19 crisis.

### **3. Home Office**

From the exception to the rule: mobile working from your office at home.

### **4. Hybrid Meetings**

Seamlessly integrating participants into virtual meeting rooms.

### **5. New Room Arrangements**

Co-working units, multimedia rooms and silent spaces are at the focus of office planning.

### **6. Activity-Based Working**

Work increasingly takes place away from the classic desk.

### **7. Reduction of storage space**

Digitalisation massively reduces the need for physical storage space.
